

History

A conversation during a taxi ride in 1996 was the start of the long-lasting relationship between Trillion Trees Australia and Bowra & O'Dea Funeral Directors.

Tim Lawrence, the taxi driver, and his passenger Joe O'Dea Jnr of Bowra & O'Dea, both passionate about the environment, discussed a vision to create a restful place for families to visit and remember their loved one surrounded by a forest. The planting of a tree would be both a living legacy and a contribution to restoration of the natural environment.

Since that conversation over 27 years ago, Trillion Trees Australia together with Bowra & O'Dea has planted thousands of native trees across Western Australia, creating Forests of Remembrance and providing vital restoration of degraded land.

Viveash Memorial Grove

The Reg Bond Riparian Woodland Restoration Project (Viveash Memorial Grove) is proudly sponsored by Bowra & O'Dea in collaboration with Trillion Trees and the City of Swan.

Planting began at Reg Bond Reserve in Viveash in 2021 and the ongoing ecological restoration work is protecting and revitalising this important riparian floodplain environment for future generations. Each year up to 5,000 native trees and understory are planted at the project site, with restoration expected to

continue until 2025.
